The impacts of Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the Commonwealth of PA





On November 16, 2023, in Phoenixville, PA, -State Senator Katie Muth (D-Chester, Montgomery and Berks), chair of the Pennsylvania Senate Democratic Policy Committee, joined Senator Jimmy Dillon (D-Philadelphia) and Senator John Kane (D-Chester/Delaware) to co-host a public hearing to explore the potential impacts of Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the Commonwealth of PA.
