“Sherrill’s Victory Signals a New Era for Labor in New Jersey”

CAMP HILL, PA — Mikie Sherrill’s gubernatorial victory is being hailed as a major win for the Teamsters and organized labor across New Jersey. Labor leaders are celebrating her pro-worker platform and commitment to collective bargaining.

Mikie Sherrill’s election as governor of New Jersey marks a pivotal moment for labor advocacy in the state. Sherrill’s victory ensures working people will have a seat at the table in state governance. Her track record as a congresswoman included strong support for labor rights, healthcare protections, and union organizing efforts.

“Mikie Sherrill’s win is a victory for every working family in New Jersey. Her commitment to collective bargaining, fair wages, and union rights proves that when labor stands united, we win”, said William Hamilton, President of the PA Conference of Teamsters.

Labor turnout surged, contributing to her landslide win. CBS News reported that voter participation increased by at least 10% in all 21 counties, with the biggest jumps in labor-heavy regions. This increase helped the New Jersey Assembly retain a pro-worker majority, reinforcing the potential for legislative progress on labor issues.

The Teamsters and other labor groups view Sherrill’s win as a mandate to push forward on issues like wage equity, workplace safety, and union expansion. Her victory speech echoed these themes, promising to fight for working families and stand up to federal policies that undermine labor rights.
