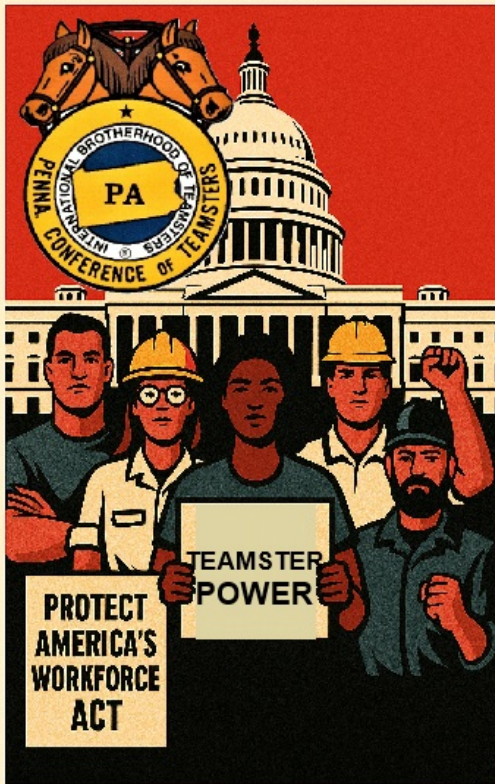

US House Moves to Repeal Trump’s Anti-Union Order



On December 10, thirteen Republicans joined every Democrat to advance the Protect America’s Workforce Act (PAWA) — repealing Trump’s March 2025 executive order that stripped bargaining rights from one million federal workers.
