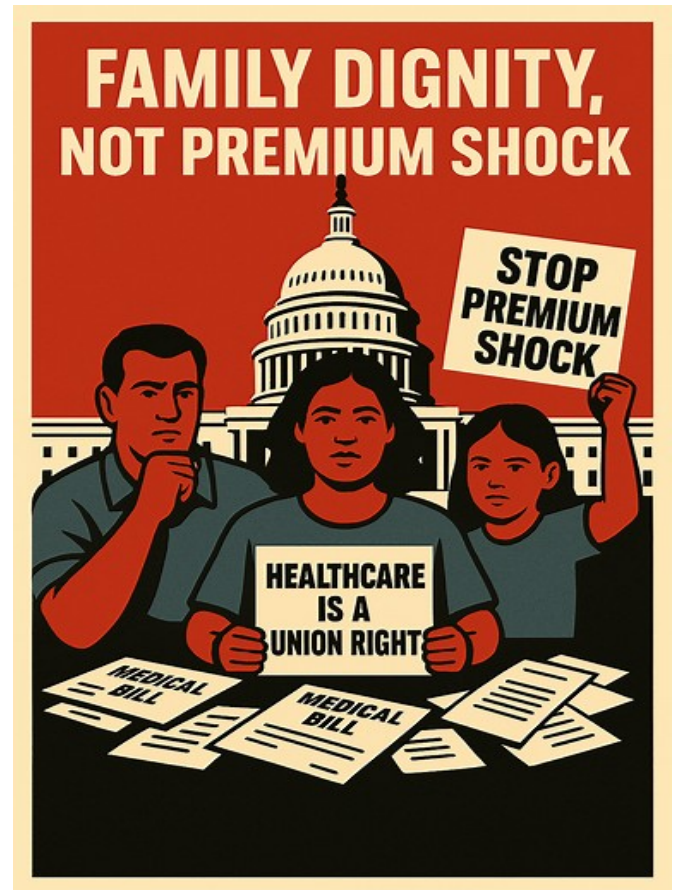
US Senate Rejects Extension of ACA Subsidies

On December 11, the U.S. Senate voted down legislation to extend Affordable Care Act subsidies. Without renewal, premiums for millions of families will double or triple starting January 2026.

This failure leaves working families exposed while politicians protect their own privileges.

What This Means for Union Families

- Premium Shock: ACA enrollees face steep increases in the new year.
- Budget Strain: Household healthcare costs will rise across Pennsylvania.
- Broken Promises: Senators walked away from families who depend on affordable care.
