## “It’s Buck Season in PA— Bucks County Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick Bucks His Party —To Protect PA’s Healthcare

**Teamsters applaud Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick for breaking with GOP leadership to defend Affordable Care Act tax credits for working families.**

*Camp Hill, PA* — The Pennsylvania Conference of Teamsters today praised Congressman Brian Fitzpatrick (R-PA) for bucking his party’s leadership and standing up for working families in the fight to protect Affordable Care Act (ACA) premium tax credits.

House GOP leaders attempted to sabotage healthcare protections by loading legislation with “poison pill” provisions designed to sink bipartisan efforts. Rep. Fitzpatrick rejected those tactics, joining Democrats in a discharge petition to force a clean vote on extending ACA subsidies that keep premiums affordable for more than 20 million Americans.

“For Teamster families across Pennsylvania and our other Conference states (NJ, DE, MD and WV) healthcare is non-negotiable,” said PA Conference of Teamsters President William Hamilton. “Rep. Fitzpatrick showed courage by bucking his party and siding with working people. His stand proves that bipartisan support exists to protect our families’ dignity and security.”

500,000 Pennsylvanians rely on ACA subsidies to keep coverage affordable. Without renewal, premiums could spike over 200% for Pennsylvania families as well as families in the all the states.

Without action, ACA premium tax credits will expire at the end of 2025, triggering sharp increases in healthcare costs for union households. The Teamsters emphasized that this fight is about fairness, health care costs and family—not partisan games.

If your Representative is opposed to renewing ACA subsidies, they are NOT protecting Pennsylvania families or the families in our other Conference states — they’re protecting insurance company profits.
