PA PUBLIC SECTOR ANTI-UNION BILLS FAIL TO MAKE IT OUT OF COMMITTEE

- [HB 844](#) – outlawing public employee contact info as a proper subject of collective bargaining
- [HB 845](#) – public notification of CBAs and arbitration awards
- [HB 2042](#) – mandating employee notification stating membership right to drop membership
- [HB 2048](#) – elimination of paycheck deduction for political contributions
